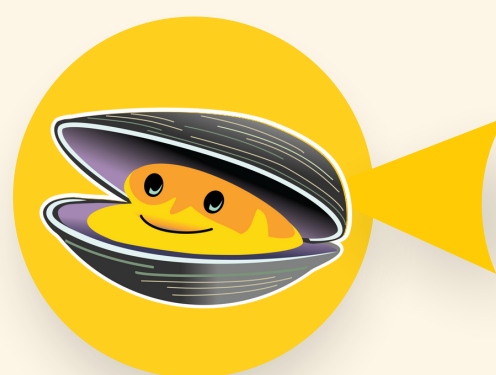

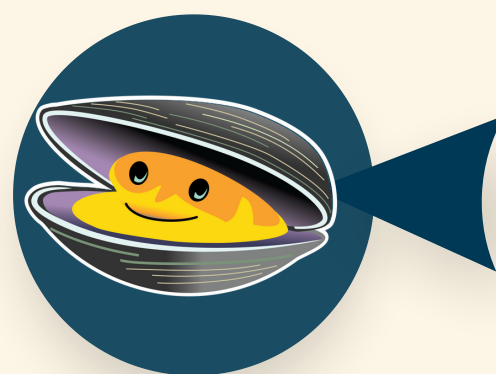

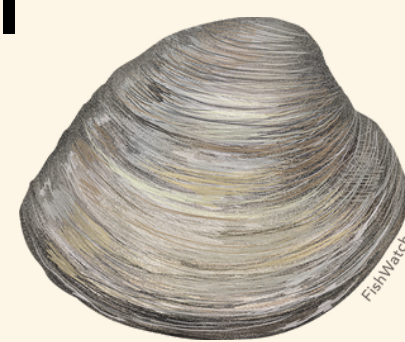
Quahogs can be
